APPLIGENT SCANS PDF DOCUMENTS

Appligent, Inc., has announced the release of APActiveCheck, a software utility that scans PDF documents for potentially damaging links, scripts and attachments.

To help prevent filings from being rejected by organizations with submissions guidelines like the International Trade Commission, companies can proactively deploy APActiveCheck to inspect all PDF files prior to submission. In addition, Appligent's free software tool, APStripFiles can be used to automatically remove embedded files. APStripFiles retains the annotation icons in a document even as it removes the files attached to those icons and will not harm comments attached to the icons as standard Acrobat annotations.

Both APActiveCheck and APStripFiles are designed to work on the command-line and can be incorporated into a workflow in an unattended environment.
