## **Appligent announces Unicode support, updates Redax**

Appligent has released Redax 3.6, its application to enable redaction, or the removal of certain text and images in PDFs. Many government and legal customers use the software for privacy protection in documents to be released to the public.

Redax 3.6 now lets Adobe Reader users view Redax annotations; furthermore, among its other new features, the application enables users to give a reason for the redaction of each deleted piece of text or image.

The Philadelphia-area company also announced that several of its product lines, including its Append/Publishing, Forms Processing and Stamping families, will support Unicode format going forward.

“Adding Unicode support to our products will satisfy many of our customers and partners who require a solution for their document management workflow that is truly global,” says Virginia Gavin, president of Appligent. “This is especially important for businesses working in the Pacific Rim that produce large volumes of PDF documents in the local languages.”
